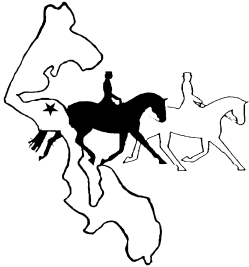

Judges:	To Be Announced.
Awards:	Ribbons 1 st to 5 th place. Cash back to 1 st place. Cash back of \$2.50 per class entry will be for 1 st place <i>only</i> .
Entry Fees:	\$22.50 (classes 1 thru 9). \$25.00 (class 10, musical freestyle).
Post Entries:	\$35.00 per class. Entries received after the closing date will be accepted as time allows. No post entry for Musical Freestyle Class 10.
Incomplete Entries:	Incomplete entries will be assessed a \$5.00 office fee.
Haul In Fee:	\$10.00 per horse
Stabling:	\$25 per day (8:30 am – 4:30 pm) Covered stabling available March, April and May shows only. All stabling in portable stalls (with doors) in field only. One horse per stall. No stabling in barn areas. All stabling is limited to space available. Overnight stabling \$40.00 per night and <u>only</u> with prior agreement with management. NO stabling reservations prior to receipt of paid entry.
Refunds:	50% of class entry if horse is unable to compete and the faxed veterinarian's excuse for the horse is received by show management 48 hours prior to first ride of the show.
NSF Checks:	Returned checks (NSF, stop payment) will have a \$40.00 assessment.
Closing Date:	Postmarked by date listed. NO fax, email or phone entries.
Dogs:	Dogs at facility are to be in stabling area and leashed at all times. NO dogs around Ring 1, Ring 2 or at concession areas. Please pick up after your pet!
Arena:	All tests to be ridden in 20 x 60 meter arena. Arena footing is either Hog Fuel (cedar) or sand.
Classes:	Classes may be combined or divided according to participation.
TOC:	Test of Choice (TOC) class may be entered only once by a horse/rider combination. Test of Choice (TOC) test number must be indicated on the entry, in the blank following the class number.
Decisions:	Judges decision is final. Ties to be broken by toss of the coin by show manager.
Ride Times:	Ride times available Tuesday prior to show at www.ridewec.com .

Every entry at a schooling show shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that the person making it, owner, lessee, trainer, coach, manager, agent, rider, and the horse: 1) shall be subject to the rules of the Whidbey Equestrian Center; 2) are eligible as entered; 3) are bound by the rules of the Whidbey Equestrian Center and will accept as final the decision of the show management on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold Whidbey Equestrian Center, and their officials, directors, agents, employees and volunteers harmless for any action taken; 4) acknowledge that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of injury, loss, or death, and they agree to hold harmless Whidbey Equestrian Center and their officials, directors, employees, volunteers and agents for any injury, loss, or death suffered during or in connection with the competition, whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees, volunteers or agents of the show, Whidbey Equestrian Center. All horses exhibited, or on facility property will be at the owners/leasee's risk. The laws of the state of Washington govern the construction or application of said rules.
